

# Make a HAT WordThing

## Supplies Provided:

- Printout of Colorable H WordThing
- Printout of Colorable A WordThing
- Printout of Colorable T WordThing
- Strips for HAT

## Additional Supplies Required:

- Tape or staples & stapler
- Glue sticks
- Child safety scissors
- Collage materials

## Educator Instructions:

1. Make sure the students have seen the episode “One HAT Fits All” before beginning the activity.

2. You may want to introduce the activity in the following way:

“Today we watched a story where we saw our WordFriends build the word HAT and make different HATS they each wore. Do you remember the different HATS they made? (Allow time for kids to answer.) One was for dressing up as a magician, one was for cooking, and one was just silly and fun. There were many kinds of HATS, but they were special WordWorld HATS, so they were made of letters. Just like our WordFriends, we are going to make HATS out of letters!”

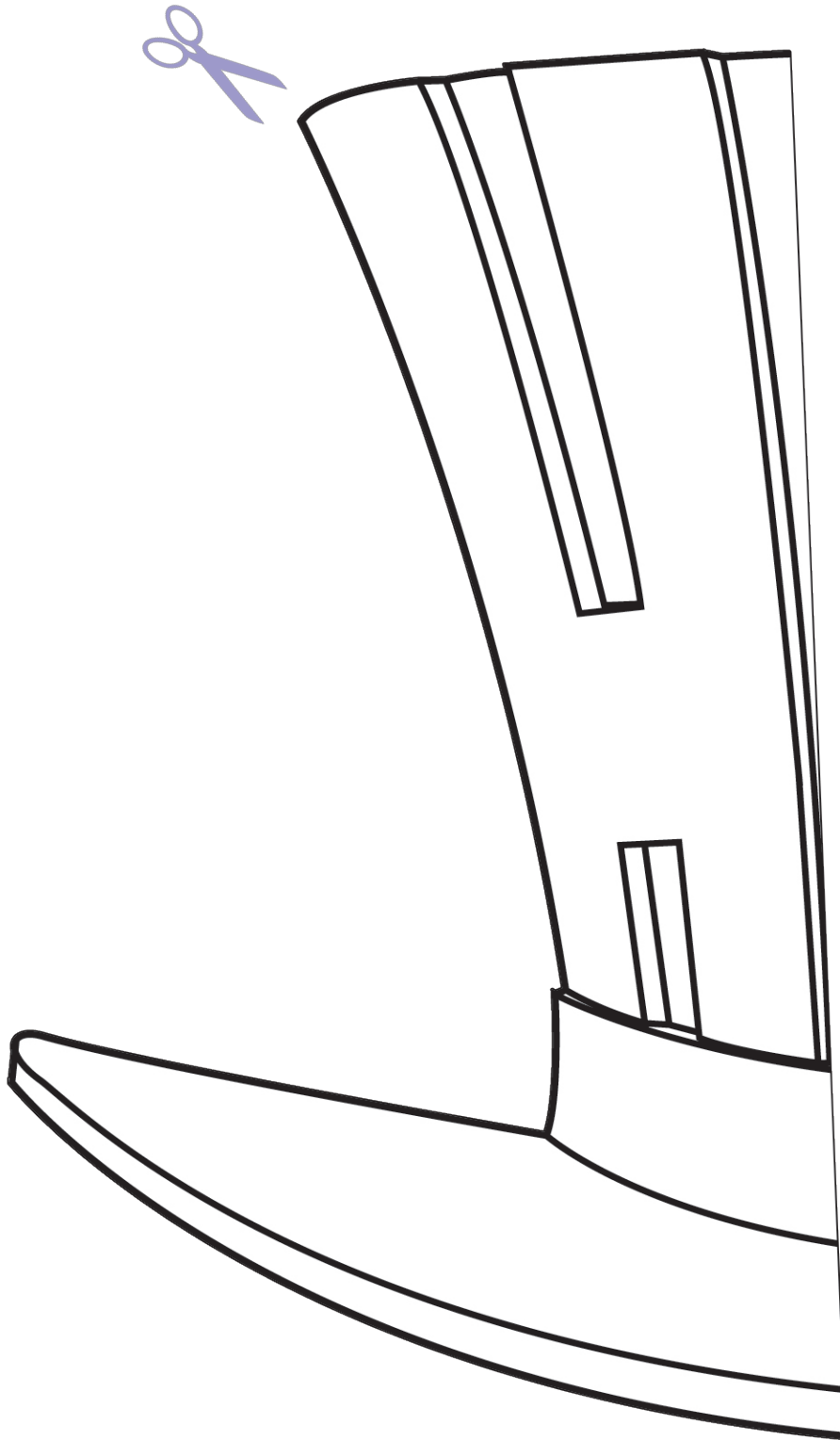
3. Explain each step of the process to the children:

1. Cut out the WordThing letters on the following three pages.
2. Cut out the strips of paper that follow on the fourth page.
3. Color and decorate the WordThing letters.
4. Tape or staple together the letters to make the HAT WordThing.
5. Tape or staple together the bottom edge of the HAT WordThing to one of the strips of paper.
6. Add strips as needed for different head sizes. Wrap strips around head and attach ends with tape or staple.
7. Congratulations! You are done!

4. Support learning by sounding out the word and helping children hear the order of the sounds and the letters.



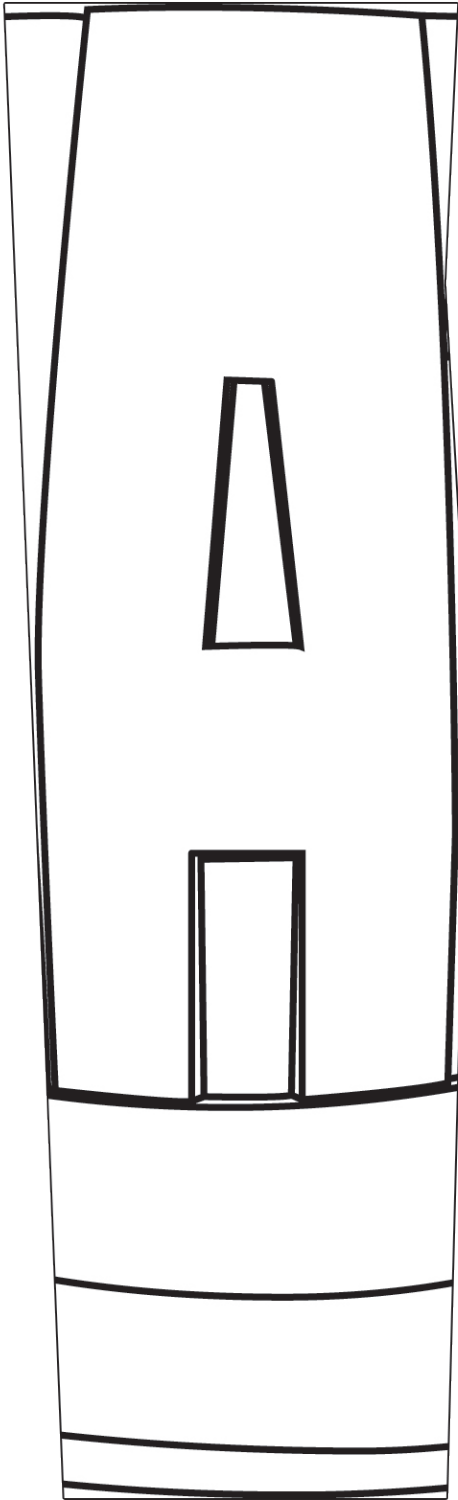

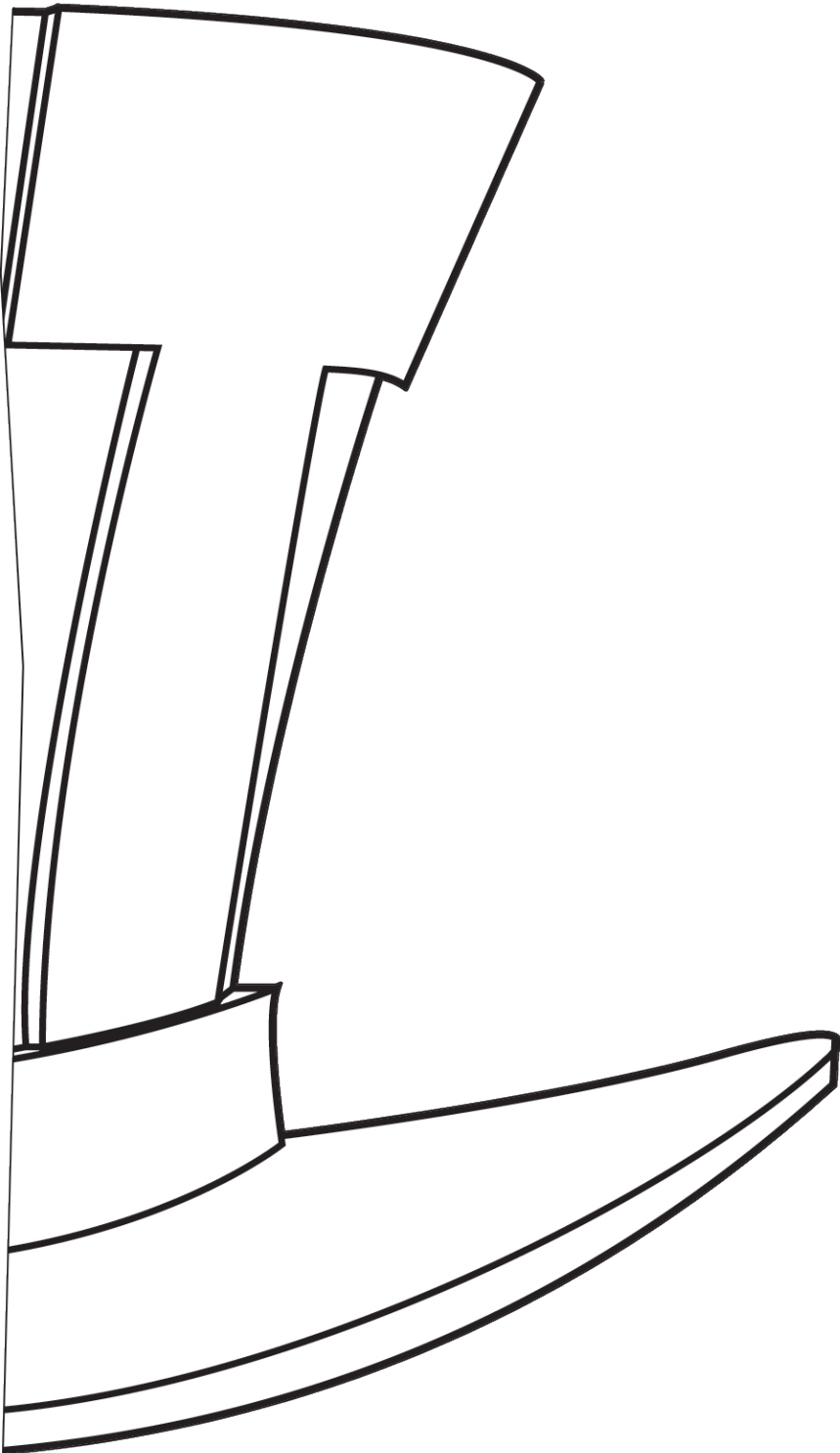
